#### **Minutes**

Committee reviews and approves minutes from August meeting.

Notes concern about propping open doors that are behind badge access—potential to note this in future drill instructions, that the doors need to not be propped open. This may also be added to the CSM website as part of standard safety procedures.

## **Debrief of Recent Safety Drills & Power Outage**

Vince Garcia recaps the Violent Intruder Drill (VID) from September 10. Justin Stevick sent in feedback about the PA system inaudible in classroom(s) in building 36—Vince will work with ITS and Emergency Management to test and address this issue. VG says that once a BC is out of the building, they do not re-enter the building—Public Safety or Emergency Management will do a secondary sweep. Vince will get managers signed up as Building Captains to increase staffing, and is working on safety training for faculty, pamphlet, presentation, safety video. Potential to make a 1-sheet about campus safety that can be added into any class syllabus

Clarification of steps taken by College leadership during an outage:

- Building evacuation begins immediately.
- CAT (Crisis Action Team) convenes and evaluates sit. and sends out RAVE message saying to remain safe in dark areas of buildings, while seeking info from PG&E about locality of the outage, estimated repair time, which usually takes about 30 minutes to get clear picture of the situation.
- Robert Gutierrez gets an automated call from PG&E to help College assess severity of outage. PG&E outage map online is available to anyone.

Justin has concerns about door access/locking and re-locking during an outage or emergency--Vince will do a building walkthrough.

Whoever set the emergency lockdown button in an emergency should also re-set the button after all is clear.

### **Health Fair Update**

Health Fair table will focus on promoting RAVE. Dr. Yang says glow stick/safety light sticks.

Thiri Thu says that a keychain with a mini flashlight could be good, perhaps as a prize for answering a quiz.
